MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION OF OAK HOLLOW

By becoming a member of the Oak Hollow Association and participating in its various activities, such as Wild Roots and Wild STEMS, whether through the association itself, any affiliated websites, or Social Media Groups, I hereby acknowledge and accept the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement of Oak Hollow Association, a Private Membership Association.

1. The primary aim of this Association is to provide the founders and members of the Private Ministerial Association with a dedicated platform for conducting private business within the Ministry, as well as with other Ministries/Associations and Ministry members. By operating within the private domain, we seek to leverage the protections granted by the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) and the United States Constitution. Our objective is to ensure that members can engage in private business transactions, while enjoying all the rights and safeguards guaranteed by the Constitution of the UNITED STATES, as well as any previous established protections.

2. Oak Hollow Association is a legally established private educational association founded on faith, specifically in Nature and Natures God. Our core mission is to provide educational services to our members. As an association, our objective is to offer the founders and all members of the Private Membership Association a dedicated platform for conducting various private business activities within the Association and with other Associations and their respective members. By maintaining all business within the private domain, we aim to utilize the protections granted by the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) and the Constitution of the United States of America. Through this approach, we enable our members to engage in private business transactions while benefiting from all the acknowledged and guaranteed protections afforded by the Constitution of the UNITED STATES, as well as any previously established safeguards.

3. We firmly uphold that our members are entitled to the absolute freedoms outlined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR), the Constitution of the United States of America, the constitutions of the individual states within the union, and the Charter of Rights of Canada. These rights include but are not limited to freedom of religion, free speech, petition, assembly, and the lawful gathering for mutual support in asserting our protected rights as enshrined in those Constitutions, Charters, and Statutes. Additionally, we recognize the rights to be free from unreasonable search and seizure, the right to avoid self-incrimination, and the right to freely exercise all other inherent and unalienable rights bestowed upon us by our creator, our almighty God, and guaranteed by those Constitutions, Charters, and Statutes.

Therefore, we hereby declare our exercise of the "freedom of association" as safeguarded by the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR), the U.S. Constitution, equivalent

provisions within State Constitutions, and the Charter of Rights of Canada. Consequently, our Association's activities are confined solely to the private domain and beyond the jurisdiction of governmental entities, agencies, officers, agents, contractors, and any other representatives, as specified by law.

4. We affirm the fundamental right of every member to independently determine which Ministry members are most suitable for providing wise counsel and advice on various aspects, such as physical, spiritual, and mental health care, education, sports, law, career, finances, and any other pertinent matter. We acknowledge and respect each member's autonomy in selecting individuals from whom they believe they can receive appropriate guidance and support. Therefore, we endorse the freedom of our members to accept counsel, advice, and tips from those individuals whom they perceive as capable of offering them the necessary assistance and guidance.

5. We uphold the right to exercise personal autonomy in selecting and implementing therapies and treatments that we deem most beneficial for the diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of illness and disease, as well as for achieving and maintaining overall well-being. Additionally, we affirm the freedom to choose any forms of assistance pertaining to legal matters and other private business activities. It is important to note that within The Association, the relationship between members is that of a contract-based association, rather than a doctor-patient relationship.

I acknowledge that by becoming a member of The Association, I am voluntarily transitioning my legal status from a public person, patient, customer, or client to a private member. I have consciously chosen this approach for natural healthcare, wellness, and disease prevention. Therefore, I understand and agree that The Association and its members cannot be held financially liable for any specific outcomes related to my health.

6. The mission of this Association is to provide members with a forum to conduct business between members in the private domain with the protections guaranteed within the aforesaid Constitution and Charter remaining fully intact.

7. The Association acknowledges individuals, regardless of their race, color, or religion, who have joined the Association or any social media group established, created, or overseen by the Association and align with its principles and policies, as members. This recognition is contingent upon the person not having been subjected to sanctions, expulsion, or any form of banishment by the Association. The Association will facilitate a platform for its members to come together, collaborate, and effectively achieve the declared objectives.

8. Membership to this Association, "Oak Hollow Private Membership Association," and any of its groups may be terminated by the association Trustees or their designee, at any time, should they conclude that a specific member is interacting with them or any other members in a way that is contrary or detrimental to the focus, principles, and betterment of this Association.

9. I acknowledge that The Association is safeguarded by the First and Fourteenth Amendments to the U.S. Constitution, which establishes its independence from the

jurisdiction and authority of Federal and State Agencies and Authorities in relation to any complaints or grievances involving The Association members or staff. Any concerns or disputes will be resolved internally by an assigned representative, committee, or tribunal, and as a member, I voluntarily waive my rights to pursue external complaints or grievances for the collective benefit of The Association and its members. By agreeing to this membership form, I affirm that I have undertaken sufficient education and understanding to make an informed decision in choosing this path for myself.

10. I agree to join Oak Hollow, a private membership association under common law, whose members seek to help each other achieve better education, counsel and good quality of life.

(A) I am voluntarily changing my capacity from that of a public person to that of a private member. My activities within The Association are a private contractual matter that I refuse to share with the Local, State, or Federal investigative or enforcement agencies. I fully agree not to pursue any course of legal action against a fellow member of The Association, unless that member has exposed me to a clear and present danger of substantive evil, and upon the recommendation and approval of the Association.

11. I willingly enter into this agreement without any external pressure or coercion. I declare that I do not represent any Local, State, or Federal agency whose purpose involves regulating or approving products or services, or carrying out enforcement, entrapment, or investigative missions. I have thoroughly read and comprehended this document, and all my inquiries have been adequately addressed to my satisfaction. I am aware that I retain the right to withdraw from this agreement and terminate my membership in this association at any time. Furthermore, I understand that engaging in abusive, violent, menacing, destructive, or harassing behavior towards any member of The Association may result in the revocation of my membership. These pages constitute the entire agreement governing my membership in The Association.
